Verification of compliance of ATR is an on-going process. Therefore, Concurrent Auditor to verify the compliance status of all the open ATRs of previous as well as current audits (audits carried out during engagement period).</p> <p>Frequency of reporting of ATR review to be monthly along with Concurrent Audit report.</p> <p>It should be included as a distinct section within the regular Concurrent Audit Report.</p> |
